### 1.1

The licensee may not sell, lease, sublicense, or otherwise assign or transfer any rights, duties or obligations under this Agreement, in whole or in part, to any person, or third-party, including by merger.

### 1.2

Upon purchasing of the licence, you become a licensed user not an owner of the software. Purchased fonts will remain copyright to Colophon Foundry and their creators.

### 1.3

Any modifications of our typefaces are not allowed. All modifications must be made by Colophon Foundry directly. Please contact us to discuss.

### 1.4

We do not give refunds, all sales are final, unless proven that the files are defective.

### 1.5

All licences are not transferrable. This means you may not transfer licences to clients once work has been completed utilising the fonts. The client must purchase their own copy of the licence, but are you allowed to purchase on behalf of the client.

### 1.6

The licence is purchased for use within a singular organisation e.g. Company Ltd. It may not be used across multiple locations without a multi-user licence.

### 1.7

Although every effort has been taken to check these fonts for viruses, in no circumstance what-so-ever do we take responsibility for damage caused to a user’s hardware, software or a loss of income that may have occurred as a result. All Colophon Foundry software installed is done so at the owner’s risk and we, Colophon Foundry, will not be held responsible.

### 1.10

We reserve the right to ask you for a copy / proof of this licence at any time.

### 1.11

Place of jurisdiction is London, United Kingdom.

### 1.12

Breach of any of these terms will result in the termination of the contract immediately, and we will revoke the licence for the purchased fonts without refund. After termination, you must destroy all copies, including backup or archival copies on external medias (e.g. a backup external hard drive).

### 2.1

Purchase of a font is for the number of user licensed for. Please make sure the number desktop users, correlates to the number of users. These users should work for the same organisation within the same location. Please contact us if you require an extension to your licence.

### 2.2

This licence does not allow the font to be loaded onto a server which provides for multiple users. Please contact us directly for a quotation on this.

### 2.3

The .OTF or .TTF (if requested) files should not be converted to any other file formats. Other independent technologies such as sIFR, @font-face, Cufon or any other online on-the-fly rendering are prohibited, if you wish to self-host our typefaces online, please purchase the appropriate licence.

### 2.4

The purchase of a font makes the buyer a licensed user of the font, not an owner. In terms of the desktop licence, this allows the user to utilised the font on all terms of materials produced on a desktop machine, including logo design, publication design, literature design, images for websites (but not embedding the fonts onto servers).
